Subject: REACH Annex XVII, Restrictions

Solenis confirms that it complies with the REACH Annex XVII legislation.

On June 1, 2009, the Annex XVII of REACH, "Restrictions on the manufacture, placing on the market and use of certain dangerous substances, preparations and articles," entered into force.

On **December 12th, 2023**, ECHA updated the list of Substances restricted under REACH, which now contains **73** unique substances, though **78** entries listed. Please use the link provided below to access the latest version of the list which includes all the restrictions adopted in the framework of REACH and the previous legislation, Directive 76/769/EEC. Each entry shows a substance, a group of substances, or a substance in a mixture, and the consequent restriction conditions.

If Annex XVII substances are present in Solenis European product portfolio at >/= 0.1%, it will be confirmed by its display on the Product's Safety Data Sheet in sections 3 and 15 in line with the restrictions as specified in the Annex XVII.

Please note that the restricted substances (on their own, in a mixture or in an article) are substances for which manufacture, placing on the market or use is limited or banned in the European Union. We trust this information satisfies your needs on this subject.
