SOLENIS POLICY Sustainable Procurement of Raw Materials

1.0 Introduction

Sustainability is crucial to Solenis, not only in what we do at our plants and facilities, but in what we do to help our customers meet their own sustainability goals. We have developed a comprehensive sustainability strategy encompassing all the environmental, social and governance elements of sustainability. Solenis' sustainability strategy can be found at https://www.solenis.com under the Sustainability - Strategy Vision section.

2.0 Policy

Solenis' objective is to qualify, maintain and improve suppliers whose attributes and behaviors could impact Solenis from safety-based, financial, ethical and environmental risks. Solenis has established a Supplier Code of Conduct which sets forth Solenis' expectations of its suppliers regarding ethical and socially responsible business practices. Supplier acknowledges that it has reviewed the Supplier Code of Conduct, which can be found at https://www.solenis.com/en/suppliers. Solenis requires its suppliers, their employees, their affiliated entities, their agents or anyone acting on behalf of the suppliers to comply with this Code of Conduct and agree to adhere to the principles contained therein or to abide by their code of conduct containing the same or similar provisions. This code is not exhaustive and suppliers are expected to use good judgment to ensure appropriate conduct relative to all applicable laws, regulations, standards and topics that are not specifically addressed in the Supplier Code of Conduct document.

In support of this objective, Solenis will seek, whenever possible, to do business with raw material suppliers who:

- adhere to Solenis' sustainability principles, and
- directly participate in the American Chemistry Council's Responsible Care* initiative, or
- be a participant of the 10 Principles of UN Global Compact, or
- are assessed by a third party for sustainability (e.g. EcoVadis), and
- commit to improve their performance in the fields of environmental protection, occupational safety and health protection, process safety, product stewardship, security, supply chain and logistics through their own internally developed programs.

The Solenis supplier needs to give permission to verify compliance, respond in a timely manner, allow on-site audits and allow employees to report concerns to Solenis.

Solenis will re-evaluate existing raw material suppliers' participation in sustainability and equivalent initiatives or internally developed programs, as applicable, on an as-needed basis. Suppliers are expected to proactively notify Solenis of any changes to their status regarding these programs. and previous information provided.

3.0 Procedure

3.1 Supplier expectations

All Solenis selected suppliers* need to provide either a current year EcoVadis assessment or a completed Raw Material Supply Sustainability Performance Survey (survey questionnaire attached to this policy).

By 2025, Solenis' goal is to drive 80 percent of our raw material suppliers (based on annual spend) to be responsive to our Sustainable Procurement expectations. Once that goal is reached, we will target the remaining supplier base, based on spend and/or supplier risk evaluation (90 percent by 2030).

3.2 Supplier evaluation

Suppliers are categorized by:

- Suppliers with a current EcoVadis assessment of bronze or higher. Completion of the Raw Material Supply Sustainability Performance Survey is not required for suppliers in this category.
- Suppliers who do not have an EcoVadis assessment, who will be required to complete the Raw Material Supply Sustainability Performance Survey and will be categorized into tiers based on risk profile and number of yes responses to the survey questions.
- The tier rating for suppliers who have an EcoVadis assessment or completed the survey are:

Tier	EcoVadis Medal	RM Survey %	Compliance Status
Tier 1	Platinum / Gold	>90%	Compliant – minimal risk
Tier 2	Silver	70% - 89%	Compliant – low risk
Tier 3	Bronze	50% - 69%	Compliant – medium risk
Tier 4	No Medal	<50%	Supplier watch – higher risk
Tier 5	Not Assessed	N/A	Non-compliant

- Global Sourcing will review any suppliers in the Tier 4 and Tier 5 categories to determine business risk and a path forward to improve sustainability performance.
- Supplier performance will be measured by evaluating the responses year over year to the Raw Material Supply Sustainability Performance Survey or Suppliers who achieve a higher EcoVadis rating. Solenis will also proactively support our non-conforming suppliers by gaining alignment with them on the development of an improved Corporate and Social Responsibility (CSR) model.
- Solenis' goal is to continuously reduce the number of Tier 4 or below suppliers, year over year, by finding alternative sources or supporting existing suppliers in addressing those survey questions with a "no" response.

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- Suppliers in the Tier 4 or below category can also be assessed after a visit to their facilities or
 office.
- Solenis' expectation toward its suppliers is a continuous improvement, so that more suppliers will be in higher tiers over time and Solenis' risk decreases continuously. Solenis will monitor progress annually.

Global Sourcing will consolidate all surveys results on an annual basis in a specific report and commits to achieving an overall score improvement according to the goals stated above.

3.3 Solenis' commitment

After the first submission, Solenis will request existing suppliers to revalidate their results on a yearly basis. Suppliers can either provide a current year EcoVadis assessment of bronze or higher or resubmit responses to the Raw Material Supply Sustainability Performance Survey.

Should Solenis determine a supplier no longer subscribes to sustainability principles, Solenis will inform the supplier in writing of the decision that it is no longer an approved source for Solenis. The supplier will be provided the opportunity to correct and / or demonstrate its adherence to sustainability principles and retain its approved supplier status.

If Solenis finds that the supplier is not acting in compliance with this policy, we will specify which issues need to be corrected or improved. The supplier must then take corrective actions promptly and provide adequate evidence of improvements. Solenis nevertheless reserves the right to cancel outstanding orders, suspend future orders, and/or terminate the main contract with the supplier in case of a material breach of this policy or the supplier refusing to take corrective actions.

We promote an open dialogue with all our suppliers and partner with them to help them meet our requirements.

This policy outlines minimum standards for our suppliers in addition to applicable laws and regulations, and it forms an integral part of all contracts between the supplier and Solenis. If there are differences between the requirements of laws and regulations and this policy, the supplier must adhere to whatever is stricter.

Solenis reserves the right to update or modify this policy at any time without prior notice.

This policy applies to Solenis. All applicable country laws, tax rules, labor contracts or company code policies are respected. No items in this policy and / or guidelines provided will overrule any such laws, regulations, etc.
